

## SOUTH AFRICA & SEYCHELLES

### Private journey – 2 guests on a sharing basis



### ITINERARY

Day1 departure from home airport to Cape Town – South Africa (night flight)

Day2 arrive in **Cape Town**, airport pickup and private transfer to 5\*hotel

**Note: Hotel check-in is at 1400 hours;** *we shall request for early check-in which would be subject to availability*

*The Mother City, as the locals call it, is located on the peninsula of the "Western Cape" and is an excellent starting point to visit the southern part of this great country called South Africa. In fact, only an hour's drive away are the vineyard region and the pretty towns of Stellenbosch and Franschhoek where the best South African wines are produced, such as Chardonnay or Cabernet Sauvignon.*

Day 5 check-out and private transfer to **Hermanus** - 5\* hotel

*The town of Hermanus is known for whale watching, the lovely giants of the seas are mainly visible from June to October across Walker Bay. However, it is a very pleasant place to visit even in summer to enjoy its beautiful beaches, admire the magnificent sunsets while tasting a good local wine.*

Day 7 check-out and private transfer to the **Winelands & Western Cape** 5\* hotel/luxury winery

*The best way to enjoy the atmosphere of the Winelands is to stop for a scrumptious lunch with local cheeses and wines at one of the renowned wineries in the area followed by a tour on the Wine Tram in the Franschhoek Valley, whose winemaking traditions date back to the late 1600s when Huguenots from France made this corner of Africa a green valley where rows of vineyards stretch as far as the eye can see.*

Day 9 **Western Cape – Kruger National Park**

check-out and private airport transfer. Domestic flight to Hoedspruit at 10.50 am arriving at 1.10 pm – direct transfer to a private concession in the Kruger (Sabi Sabi, Kapama, Thornybush) check-in at luxury lodge 4\*/5\* or 5\*L.

Overnight and afternoon activities at the Lodge.

*The private concessions in or close to the park gates offer the most luxurious and exclusive lodges on the entire continent, a favourite destination for the jet set and many celebrities but also for anyone who wants to have a unique safari experience. On board specially modified 4x4 vehicles, expert guides, rangers and trackers accompany guests in search of the Big Five and other big predators at dawn, while the sun rises and nature slowly wakes up. In the afternoon, the fiery sunset in the bush invites to an open-air aperitif to admire the awe-inspiring beauty of nature in religious silence before returning to the lodge. There the dim light of torches illuminates the pathways leading to the boma in the middle of which a fire burns and unforgettable dinner under the stars is about to begin.*

Day 10 early morning safari, lunch and relax at the lodge. Afternoon safari, dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day 12 **Kruger – Johannesburg**

Check-out and private transfer to Hoedspruit airport. Domestic flight to Johannesburg.

Arrival in Johannesburg, airport pickup and private transfer to the hotel (4\* or 5\*), free afternoon (the apartheid museum closes at 5.00 pm Mon/Sun).

AT YOUR CHOICE: road transfer to Johannesburg (8-hour drive approximately, with private car and driver) through the scenic Panorama Route, connecting various places of interest in the Mpumalanga Province.

*Johannesburg, a symbol of South Africa's history; a city of 5 million inhabitants, it is the economic and financial capital of the country characterized by ultra-modern skyscrapers and luxury hotels, but also by places that tell the story of a notorious past such as the apartheid museum and the Soweto township, a symbol of the struggle against apartheid. Located about 50 km from Johannesburg, Pretoria is one of the three capitals of South Africa, a quiet city full of historic buildings and fascinating museums. Also known as "Jacaranda City" from the purple flower trees.*

Day 13 Johannesburg & Pretoria

Day 14 **Johannesburg – Seychelles** ("Island Hopping" Mahé and/or Praslin and/or La Digue)

*As soon as you get off the plane at Mahe airport, the spectacular beauty of the Seychelles strikes your senses as you are greeted by the unmistakable tropical heat and the lush,*

*luxuriant, otherworldly natural landscape of these islands.*



Check-out and private transfer to O. R. Tambo International Airport. International flight to the Seychelles. Arrival at Mahe airport in the evening, connecting flight to Praslin (if required). Check-in and overnight at 5\* resort.

Day 17 Check-out and transfer to Mahé Island (or La Digue)

Transfers between Praslin, Mahé or La Digue (at your choice) are operated by ferries at scheduled departure timings. These fast catamarans travel the distance between Praslin and La Digue in a scenic 15-minute trip. Praslin>Mahé 1 hour.

Arrival and transfer to 5\* or 5\* L Resort

Day 21 departure to your home airport.

Day 22 arrive at home airport and end of the journey.
